PREPARING A HIGHWAY FOR THE LORD



As Islanders, we know all too well about the challenge of roads: endless closures, diversionary routes, damaging pot-holes...But, as Pilgrims of Hope, we journey on, and at the same time, in the holy season of Advent, we are invited to prepare a highway for the Lord as he comes to visit his people.

The prophet Baruch, in this Sunday's first reading, speaks of the exiled and scattered people of God,

returning to their homeland, and especially their capital Jerusalem — here personified, as she "sees her children gathered from west and east". Mountains and hills are made low, and valleys filled to make a level highway for them to walk safely in the glory of God.

This finds an echo in the Gospel of St Luke, with John the Baptist in the wilderness proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, and (quoting Isaiah), calling for a "way" to be prepared: crooked paths straightened, valleys filled, and mountains laid low.

The holy season of Advent is a time to reflect on how we may have meandered and wandered from the straight path, descended into valleys of negativity, doubt or despondency, or set up mountains and hills of pride, arrogance or selfishness. In this period of scrutiny and self-examination, illumined by the Holy Spirit, we recognise, as today's psalm voices, our struggle and cry to God, sowing in tears and reaping in song, and coming home full of joy. May we, as the Apostle prays, in the Epistle, for the church at Philippi, become pure and blameless in preparation for the Day of Christ Jesus – that our lives may become fitting highways for the coming King of kings and Lord of lords, ready for us to be born anew in him and he in us.

This month, let the paradox of Christ's birth and childhood strike us a new. Let us pray with Mary in the words of an ancient hymn by St Ephrem the Syrian: "I am your Mother but I will give honour to you. I have engendered you, but you are older than I am. I have carried you in my womb, but you sustain me on my feet. You have been born of me like a little one, but you are as strong as a giant. The height of the heavens are filled with your majesty, and yet my womb has not been too small for you."

SUPPORT FOR OUR HOSPICE Our priests and the Island Pastoral Council have agreed that there will be a second collection after all Masses next weekend, 14/15 December, Gaudete Sunday, in support of the Mountbatten hospice. There are two reasons for this: first, they urgently need financial support and secondly, as a response to last week's Parliamentary vote on assisted suicide. We and the whole Church oppose this legislation but we have to do more by offering an alternative and positive vision. The antidote to assisted suicide is better palliative care and on the Island we rely heavily on our hospice for this.
