English – Reading	In our reading lessons this half term, we will be exploring "Toby and the Great Fire of London" and "Footprints in the Snow". During our reading lessons we will be making inferences, making predictions and forming links and connections to our own experiences.	Please continue to hear your child read at home, 5 times a week if possible. It will make such a positive difference on your child's fluency. Ask questions which encourage your child to draw inferences about the characters' feelings, thoughts and emotions.

Our decodable reading books link to our phonics scheme.  In Year 2, we will continue to apply our phonics within our spellings, but will also be continuing looking at spelling patterns and rules.
