PSHE	This half term, we will continue our topic 'Created and Loved by God', we will explore ourselves as individuals and learn more about the importance of valuing ourselves as the basis for personal relationships. Computing	In computing, the children will develop their understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one. They will use yes/no questions to gain an understanding of what attributes are and how to use them to sort groups of objects. The children will create physical and on-screen branching databases.
