

## Science

Year 1 will be continuing to identify a range of different animals and their features.

Year 2 will be learning about living things and their habitats. They will also explore how animals are adapted to survive.

## Geography/History

We will be continuing our learning about Africa and Kenya, before moving on to History where we will learn all about Grace Darling. We will also visit Bembridge Lifeboat station as part of our learning.

## PE

In PE we will be focusing on athletics and practising for Sports Day.

## PSHE

We will explore our relationship with the wider world. We will learn how human beings are relational by nature and are called to love others in the wider community through service, through dialogue and working for the Common Good.



## Art

Year 1 and 2 will be learning about mechanisms and making a moving picture containing sliders and levers. Our moving picture will link in with our History topic all about Grace Darling.

## Mathematics

Year 1 will be recognising and using coins. We will focus on counting in 2s and 10s to calculate before moving on to comparing mass in different contexts.

Year 2 will be recapping addition and subtraction and moving on to recognising that addition and subtraction are inverse operations. We will move on to statistics where we will carry out an investigation around the colour of Smarties!

## Music

We will learn how events, actions and feelings within stories can be represented by pitch, dynamics and tempo.

## RE

We will learn about the events that follow the Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus, the actions of the apostles and the establishment of the early Church.

## Computing

We will continue our learning on programming. Following on from Spring 2, we will develop our understanding of instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes.

## Phonics

We will recap Phase 5 GPCs and tricky words in preparation for the Phonics Screening Check.

## English

Year 1 will be using the text 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' to write a retell of the story. We will then move on to 'Oliver's Vegetables' and write a letter summarizing Oliver's week. Year 2 will be reading 'The Little Wooden Robot and the Log Princess' and writing a sequel to the story where the characters go on an exciting adventure! We will then move on 'The Night Gardener' and write descriptions of the topiaries in the park, using a range of sentence types.
