SACRIFICE AND REMEMBRANCE



As we recall, on Remembrance Sunday, the fallen in war – those who gave their lives for their country – it is providential that the readings this year speak of sacrifice.

First, we hear of the widow of Zarephath who, in a time of famine, shares her last meal with a hungry stranger, Elijah the prophet (1 Kings 17:10-16). She trusts in him and in return for her sacrificial kindness, from thenceforth her earthenware jar, or "cruse", has a perpetual supply of oil (the origin of the name of the Cruse bereavement charity which pours out endless kindness).

The Gospel (Mark 12:38-44) tells of another widow, living in poverty in Jerusalem, who gives to God all that she has to live on, unlike those who give only from the left-overs of their abundant wealth. Like the widow in Elijah's day, she effectively abandons herself to divine providence, entrusting herself in sacrifice to whatever lies ahead. "God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Cor 9:7), whether we're giving of material things, or of our time, talents and energy. Reluctant or grudging giving isn't what God wants, nor is the giving out of our spare change. And there is no promise of a generous reward for our cheerful giving — no everlasting cruse of oil necessarily awaiting us. Ours is not the way of the so-called "prosperity Gospel" which proclaims financial blessing and physical wellbeing when we give to the Church!

In the second reading, from the letter to the Hebrews (9:24-28), we are told of the true temple of heaven into which Christ, through his self-offering, has entered, lifting redeemed humanity into divinity.

At this time of saluting those who gave their freedom for ours, we are ever mindful of the Saviour who made the unique ultimate sacrifice, inviting a response from us of cheerful generosity, entrusting ourselves sacrificially to the providence of God.

Whole-Island Celebration of Mass at Christ the King school, on 24th November.

The current Novena of Prayer. For information about this and the remaining events see the Parish Website. (Feedback so far is very largely positive and constructive.)

Changes to Governance of our Primary Schools: No Catholic School has yet been proposed for closure. County is carrying out a 'survey' of opinions about a way forward. Catholics might wish to respond, stressing that Catholic Schools welcome children of all faiths and none. They also provide education and care beyond the School, for the families and members of the community

Our single Island Parish will require a new name – the Bishop has invited the Committee to suggest 3 names. One suggestion is "Holy Spirit". Others to be discussed at future meetings – parishioners are invited to submit suggestions.

Strategies for enabling more parishioners to help share the burden of work in the Parish were begun and will continue to be discussed at future meetings, as will suggestions for helping the Church to reach out more to current and potential parishioners – this may include a Day Retreat for Parishioners in the "Pilgrims of Hope" Jubilee Year, 2025.
