TRUE WISDOM - AND CHRIST'S TEMPLE

Now nearly halfway through our Lenten journey, we are reminded that the Way of the Cross – our walk with the Crucified One – may seem like foolishness to the world. Yet, as the Apostle says in today's Epistle, "Christ is the power and wisdom of God", for "God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength".



The Old Testament reading this Sunday tells of the

Ten Words, the Decalogue, commandments from God through Moses, to give wisdom to us, the simple. This Law of God's Love is not abolished in Christ but finds fulfilment in the Word made flesh, who gives in self-surrender the "temple" of his body for destruction – and resurrection – as the Gospel proclaims, in the Cleansing of the Temple.

In infancy the Lord was presented in the same Temple, and acclaimed by Simeon, not only as a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory for God's people Israel, but "set for the fall and rising of many in Israel, a sign that is spoken against". To the Hebrews, says St Paul, he is indeed "a stumbling block", and folly to the Gentiles. But the temple or sanctuary of his body, offered upon the Cross, while a stumbling block to many who reject him, now becomes the chief cornerstone of a spiritual temple. In this temple we, the Body of Christ, are being built as "living stones" and indwelt by the Holy Spirit.

In our Lenten pilgrimage we ask that Christ may overturn any tables of selfishness and corruption in our lives, that we as his temple may be cleansed. Let us come to him, the true Wisdom and Word of God, the Living Stone, in whom we – a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people – are called out of darkness into his marvellous light.
