Subject	What are we learning?	How can you help at home?
English – Writing	In Year 1, we are going to be reading Emily Gravett's 'Tidy'. Through this text we will be exploring the different characters and then writing a letter of apology. Phonics	In Phonics this half term, Year 1 will be learning Phase 5 sounds. We will be having daily phonics lessons, and targeted reading groups three times a week. Our reading books are fully decodable, and they link to our phonics scheme.	We follow the Little Wandle Synthetic Phonics Scheme at Holy Cross. SPAG	In Year 2, the children will be completing SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) sessions during Year 1 Phonics lessons. The children will also be learning new comprehension skills such as skimming and scanning.	Encourage your child to correctly punctuate their writing at home, can they extend their use of punctuation using exclamation marks, question marks or ellipsis?
Maths 21	In Year 1, we will be looking at addition and subtraction in relation to mass. We will of course be looking at this in lots of fun, practical ways! Our second topic will be multiplication and division, then geometry and finally onto number and place value. In Year 2, we will be focusing on positional and directional geometry, making links with fractions. We will revisit measures and re-cap briefly on length and mass, as well as looking at measuring capacity and temperature. There is also an	Spellings are taught through Spelling Shed every Friday. 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Geography	In Geography, we are going to be exploring the UK! In this topic, the children will be learning about the countries of the UK, the capital cities and some of their key locational features.	Help locate the UK with your child on a globe. Have the children ever been to any of the other countries of the UK, what were they like? Perhaps research some different pictures and compare the countries.
Science	In Science, we will be observing, comparing, classifying and describing UK plants. We will be exploring different types of plants such as wild plants, garden plants and trees. We will be using terms such as 'deciduous', 'evergreen', 'leaves', 'stem', 'flower', 'blossom' and many more to describe a wide variety of plants.	Perhaps explore different plants and trees with your child. Can they name the different parts? What trees do they notice stay the same through the seasons? Do any of them change?
Art & Design	In Art, we will be delving into the topic of 'Botanical Prints'. The children will have the opportunity to observe, sketch and have a go at different print techniques.	Perhaps have a look at different botanical prints online with your child. Have they got a favourite one? What do they like about it?
PE	We are focusing on Games for Understanding (Golf), Outdoor Adventurous Activities and Cricket & Rounders in PE this half term. Children should come into school wearing PE kits. We may do PE outside so please ensure your child is dressed accordingly. Our PE days are Thursdays and Fridays	Please also make sure your child has the correct PE kit. PSHE	Our topic in PSHE this half term is 'Created to Love in Community'. This topic spans all of the Summer Term, and it explores our relationships with the wider world. Homework	 Daily reading – recording it in the reading record (15mins). Children need their reading book and reading record in school every day. Year 1 – Practise the sounds your child is learning - You can use the parent page on Little Wandle to support you. (10mins) Weekly maths and spelling activity. Homework is set on a Friday and due on a Friday. Each piece of homework handed in will be rewarded with 2 dojos! In Year 1 and 2 children can earn dojos for excellent work, behaviour or kindness towards others. Once your child earns 30 dojos they can choose a prize from the prize box!
