| Subject   | What are we learning?   | How can you help at home?  |

| English   | In English we will be learning through two new stories, 'Libba' and<br>'Native America Stories'. These texts link well with the topic in<br>Geography. We will learn to extend our sentence with more than<br>one clause, using a wide range of conjunctions. We will continue to<br>think of interesting sentences using a precise range of vocabulary.<br>We will finally create a persuasive advert.                               | We would still love you to hear your child read as often as possible and<br>they will bring home a school book. We will also be encouraging<br>reading for pleasure in school through regular visits to our school<br>library.<br>Your child will receive weekly spellings, please support them with these<br>words from the Year 3/4 statutory spelling list. |
| Maths<br>2/7 $2/4$ $3/46/8$ $1/2$ $3/71/4$ $5/10$ $3/8$ | In Maths this term we will be looking at fractions, children will<br>learn about how fractions can be seen as part of a whole and that<br>to find a unit fraction, they divide the whole into equal parts. They<br>then identify the role of the denominator, appreciating that this<br>shows how many equal parts the whole has been divided into.<br>After this we will look at Mass and Capacity and how to measure<br>accurately. | Please encourage your children to use the TT Rockstars games to increase the speed of their times tables.  |
| RE  | We will begin with Lent. The children will further explore Lent as a<br>time when we prepare for Easter. It enables pupils to look at how<br>this preparation involves change. We will consider how Jesus<br>changed the people he met and deepened his relationship with the<br>Father through prayer.   | Encourage your child to discuss their learning about Lent. Do they know why we celebrate Lent? Have they given anything up for Lent?   |
| Topic   | In Geography we are learning all about North America. We will look<br>at how to locate it on the map. Then we will discuss the physical<br>features and trade zones, and how these compare to Europe.   | Use the library or the internet to further investigate life in North<br>America.   |
| Science   | This term our topic in Science is Forces and Magnets. The children<br>will be taught about magnets, magnetic materials and how to<br>identify them. | Art & DT  | The children will be learning to build electrical circuits in DT. We will look at the components needed to build a successful circuit and then move on to design our own. The children will be given a design brief to work to and will creatively build their own electrical monsters.   | If you and your child would like to create circuits at home we would love to see them!   |

| Music    | The children will be learning through the 'Dragon Song'. They will<br>learn to improvise, compose and play an instrumental part. We will<br>take inspiration from different music but refer back to the 'Dragon<br>Song'.   | We would love it if you could share music with your child at home. If<br>they learn a song or an instrument and would like to share it with us,<br>that would be wonderful!  |
| French   | This 'Family & Friends' unit will teach the children how to identify<br>and introduce family and pets and spell their names. They will also<br>learn the names for places in their own home.  | Ask your child to share the new vocabulary they have learned with you.   |
| Homework | <ul> <li>For Homework this term, we are prioritising the key skills children need to underpin their learning: Reading, Spelling and Times Tables.</li> <li>Please ensure your child reads their reading book several times per week, and this needs to be recorded in their reading record.<br/>Children need to bring their reading book and reading record into school every day</li> <li>Spellings should be practised regularly and will be tested weekly</li> <li>Practise times tables and the related division facts daily using <u>Times Tables Rockstars</u> – your child should have brought home a log in for this.</li> </ul> |  |
