#### Science

We will be learning about Everyday Materials'. Year I will be investigating and identifying a range of different materials and their uses. Year 2 will be looking closely at the properties of materials and classifying them. Both classes will be conducting a range of experiments to practice scientific enquiry skills.

We will be building our agility, balance and coordination, through playful challenges. We will be practising running, jumping, throwing and catching in athletics, and using a range of sports equipment.

We are learning how we are created by God out of love, and we will develop an understanding of the importance of valuing ourselves as the basis of personal relationships.

We will become familiar with our Mission Statement and prayers, before moving on to Creation and Catholic Social Teaching.


## Computing

We will be learning about information technology (IT) around us. We will develop our understanding of what IT is and will begin to identify examples. We will discuss where we have seen IT in school and beyond, in settings such as shops, hospitals and libraries. We will then investigate how IT improves our world, and we will learn about the importance of using IT responsibly.

## **Phonics**

We will recap Phase 3 and Phase 4 GPCs and then start to learn new Phase 5 GPCs.



Geography

We will be learning about 'Where I Live' We will learn to name the seven continents of the world and locate the UK on a world map. We will then identify the countries and capital cities of the UK, before describing their features and characteristics. We will then explore the town we live in and describe where we live.

#### DT

We will be exploring different types of homes and what makes them strong and stable, then designing and building a model house for "Jim" that stands up, has a roof, a working door and at least one window. We'll practise safe cutting, joining and simple hinges, before evaluating what went well and what we'd improve.





# Mathematics

We will be recapping number and place value skills from our previous year group. We will represent numbers in a variety of different ways, using a range of resources such as number lines. counters and part-whole models. We will then move on to comparing and ordering numbers and using our number bonds to partition.

# English

Year I and 2 will be using a take on Jack and the Beanstalk to write a character description and a recount of the story. In Reading, we will be exploring the text 'The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig' and we will discuss our opinions about the book and practise our retrieval skills.
