Especially, the Gospel reading says that God sent His only begotten Son to redeem us. He knows that he will go through trials and will die for us. Because he loves us so much. If we reflect on our Mother Mary, when she was told by the Angel about her Son, Jesus she was ready to sacrifice herself to bringing Jesus into the world. I would like to quote from book of Proverbs about a perfect wife and mother. "A perfect wife-who can find her? She is far beyond the price of pearls. Her husband's heart has confidence in her; from her he will derive no little profit. She holds out her hand to the poor, she opens her arms to the needy. Strength and honour are her clothing; she is confident about the future. Her mouth is full of wisdom; kindly teaching is on her tongue.
